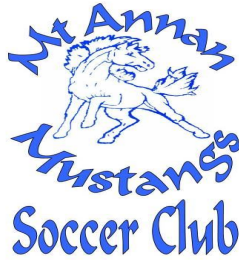
A Message from our Secretary

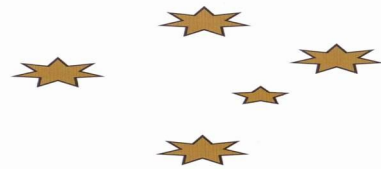

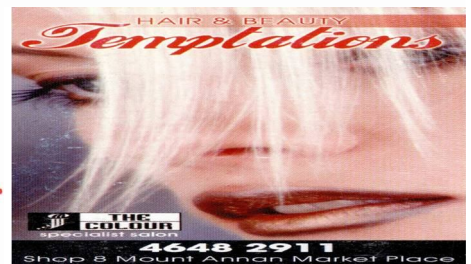
